You’ve crossed the line from hustle to structure—from effort to intention.



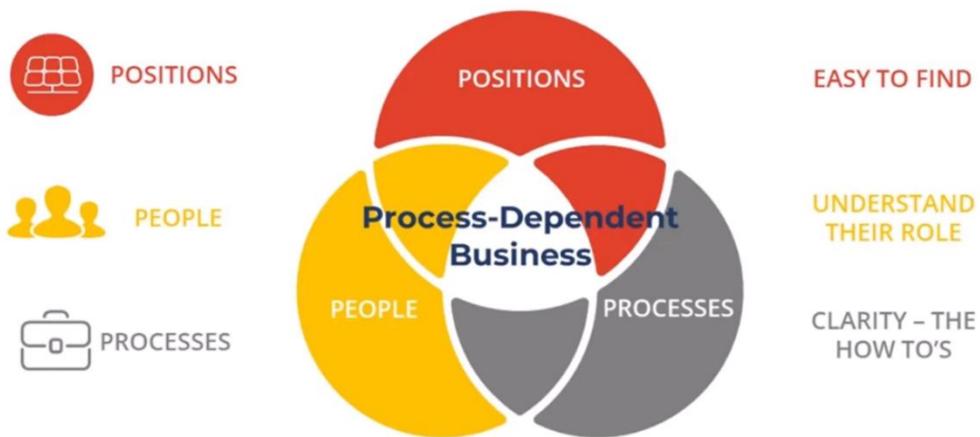
